

Introduction: What Can We Expect From Remote Viewing?

Remote viewing is the process of obtaining information through non-ordinary means, meaning other than through the five senses and memory. It has been scientifically validated for over 3 decades. Our mission at the Kari Beem Research Institute is to develop medical and practical applications of remote viewing, not to rehash the public debate over whether or not it represents a real human ability.

We are releasing these otherwise internal documents to educate the public as to what remote viewing is in the practical arena. And more importantly, what it is not. We want the general public to start to understand what practical information can be realistically gathered from remote viewing and how to best use that information. It will have importance in our ordinary lives, from how to best understand what intuition is, or how to get the most out of a medium if you should happen to consult with one.

Remote viewing involves accessing information from the “unconscious mind”. We define this as the second consciousness. It consists primarily of sensory information, emotions, and entwined memory/emotion/sensory mental fragments. Somewhere in this mix, our memories intersect as well, in a poorly understood way. The existence of this second consciousness has been documented for over 200 years and is not controversial, although not well known to the general public.

Therefore, the best information obtained through remote viewing often is primary sensory information, shapes, and colors, basic sketches of land and water elements, emotions, and primary perceptions. Any nouns or complex descriptions of the remote target are simply the left brain attempting to make sense of what is being presented to it. A target, for us, means any cluster of meaningful information. For example, a target often is a real landscape or event in current consensual reality. However, a target could also be a dead relative, or a spiritual vision, or the thought processes of an unconscious person. We do not attempt to view future events even though they obviously are information. It is more difficult to do, perhaps because the future exists as a probability not as a real event.

We work as a team. We represent all the remote viewing modalities, but our emphasis is using the monitor/viewer structure of controlled remote viewing. However only one team represents the highly structured protocol approach to controlled remote viewing. One individual has successfully blended controlled remote viewing with the freeform remote viewing that psychics and mediums have typically used.

We release all information to the client. Often the client finds meaning in the information that we miss. We use a monitor/viewer pair precisely so that the viewer does not have the pressure to name or describe the target in real life terms. Ultimately the client must decipher and use the information and decide its value and meaning.
